OUTCOMES

The activities of implementation of the Hungarian part of the project

Hungarian partner will purchase low budget vessel for hydrological surveying. Collected data will then be used for creation of a digital map of Drava river which will be a base for development of the touristic mobile phone application.

The activities of implementation of the Croatian part of the project

Within the Croatian part of the project, tourism guide and mobile application will be made. They will cover both sides of Drava river, so tourists can easily find local attractions and other points of interest.

Presentation of the hydrological recording system

The Hungarian vessel for hydrological surveying will be equipped with the GPS and sonar. Software for storing and processing data will also be part of vessel's recording system.

Possibilities for development of nautical tourism on the Drava River

To ensure development of nautical tourism on the Drava River further upstream improvements of infrastructure need to be achieved. Also measures to enable safe navigation need to be implemented. Drava river is currently navigable for "big" vessels (international class IV) only to the city of Osijek, for "smaller" vessels (class III) up to rkm 54 and for recreational navigation up to Ždalica (class II - rkm 198).
